

Dominica – June 8, 2010 – Rosalie Bay Resort, on the island of Dominica in the southern Caribbean will open August 1, 2010 and will be powered almost entirely by natural energy. A Norwin 225 wind turbine, the island's first, will generate up to 70 percent of the resort's electricity with rooftop solar panels providing the remaining power.

"Nature should be preserved and shared," said Dr. Ken Watson, general manager. "Rosalie Bay Resort was designed to be environmentally sustainable while showcasing one of the most beautiful natural settings in the Caribbean. Many resorts claim to be green, but we've made a legitimate commitment with the wind turbine being the centerpiece of our pledge."



The wind turbine generated its first watt of electricity on June 7. Dominican Utilities and Dominica's Independent Regulatory Commission developed protocol for completing the project while a team of four independent consultants, Brad Lipets, Steven Maxfield, Sven Nielson and Peter Olsen, worked with Dominican electricians and engineers to make renewable energy in Dominica a reality.

"This project has been a true group effort and it's been inspiring to see so many people are committed to the preservation of Dominica," said Brad Lipets, project coordinator. "We want to thank everyone at Dominican Utilities and Dominica's Independent Regulatory Commission for working with us to make this project a success."
